1.0 POLICY STATEMENT

Information We Collect

We collect personal information to support our services, programs, and operations. This information may include:

- Information provided, including through forms, applications, surveys, or participation in our programs
- Other relevant data needed to fulfill our mission and serve our community

We collect this information by fair and lawful means, and, when appropriate, with stakeholder knowledge or consent.

How We Use Your Information

We collect and use personal information solely to support our mission and better serve our community. We do **not** sell, rent, or trade your personal information to third parties, nor do we engage in targeted advertising.

We may use personal information to:

• Communicate with stakeholders

- Provide services, programs, or support
- Comply with legal or regulatory obligations
- Improve our services and operations

Stakeholder Rights

Depending on the stakeholders' state of residence and applicable laws, stakeholders may have certain rights regarding personal information. These may include the right to:

- Confirm whether we process personal data.
- Request access to the personal data on file.
- Ask for corrections to any inaccurate or incomplete information.
- Request that we delete personal data, subject to legal requirements.
- Request a copy of personal data in a usable format.
- **Be informed that we do not sell personal data**, and therefore do not offer an opt-out of sale.

For Iowa residents, these rights are provided under the **Iowa Consumer Data Protection Act** (**ICDPA**). For other states or countries with specific privacy rights, a stakeholder can contact us to inquire about options.

We collect information by fair and lawful means, and when appropriate, with the stakeholder's knowledge or consent.

To exercise rights, a stakeholder can contact us using the information below. We will respond within the timeframe required by law.
